

At least two (2) staff who are at least 18 years of age, who meet childcare worker qualifications and have a current Infant-Child (Pediatric) Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation Certification (CPR) and a current First Aid Certificate shall be present during all hours of operation. There shall be a second staff person, age 18 or older available in the center building or on the premises, whenever seven (7) or more children are present. Required staff-child ratios shall be met at all times. Children younger than age 2½ years shall be grouped separately from children older than 2½ years of age. There was only one person in the building with children 4 months to 4 years of age upon the arrival of the DHR representative., Ad Hoc Comments: NA	Pending Correction
Required staff-child ratios shall be met at all times. Children younger than age 2½ years shall be grouped separately from children older than 2½ years of age. There was a 4-month-old in the room with the 2 1/2 to 4year old children., Ad Hoc Comments: NA	Pending Correction
Required ratios shall be maintained at all times. In the infant room there were 6 children ages 6 week to 18 months with 1 staff person., Ad Hoc Comments: NA	Pending Correction
Staff persons shall be free from all other duties during the hours they are working directly with the children. The staff person with the 2 1/2 to 4 year old classroom was also cooking lunch as well as being the classroom teacher., Ad Hoc Comments: NA	Pending Correction
